

The Christian Disciple Festival

is a unique Christian immersion experience designed to work in conjunction with The Christian Disciple Farm and other mission projects taking place in southeast Wisconsin that same week. The festival takes place at Harnischfeger Park starting August 5th and ending August 11th. It is designed primarily for youth and young adults (ages 14 - 24), although all ages are welcome.

Cost - \$125 covers lodging, all meals and activities for 6 nights. (\$ 21/day).

Festival Activities

Adventure Activities - canoeing, kayaking, swimming, hiking, fishing, mini-putt golf, disc golf, volleyball & basketball.

Classes- Beading, tie dye, and other classes.

The Sharpening - a series of bible studies, speakers, and testimonies designed to help the participants become better disciples.

Entertainment - Christian music, drama or other entertainment on some nights.

Volunteer Brochure

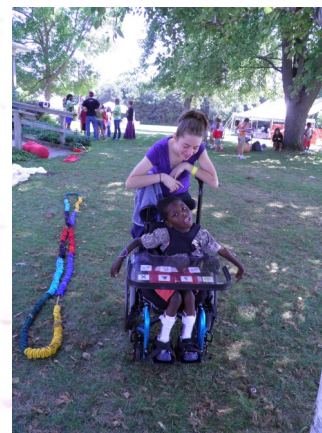


The Christian Disciple Farm (Aug. 8-12) provides an enhanced vacation bible school day camp for children & young adults (ages 3-21) with special needs and their families in an outdoor farm environment. A wide variety of activities, education, crafts, worship, entertainment and music will work together to bring the camp theme to life. Special programming will be provided for teens, young adults, Moms and Dads.

As a volunteer, you will be enabling the campers to learn more about Christ and grow in their faith while you experience God's presence in a new and exciting way. Many different volunteer opportunities exist requiring various commitment and skill levels.

200 Volunteers needed

This is a great opportunity for volunteers to participate in a very rewarding program. Due to the outdoor setting of this camp and the special needs of the children there is a large need for volunteers. We expect over 120 campers.



One of the most rewarding jobs is being a "buddy" to a child with special needs. "Buddies" facilitate the children so that they get the most out of their camp experience. Each child with a special need will have a full-time buddy that is assigned to them for the entire week. Minimum age for a buddy is 14.

Some of the other volunteer jobs are, helping with crafts, games, fishing, rock-wall climbing, photography, grounds keepers, nature studies, horses, and helping in the kitchen. A complete list of jobs with description and minimum age requirements can be found on the website.

The day camp takes place Monday through Friday from 9AM to 2:15PM at Raspberry Hill Farm. This is a private farm located about halfway between Madison and Milwaukee near the town of Sullivan. It has 41 beautiful acres of woods, fields and a fishing pond. Lunch is provided daily for campers and volunteers. There is no cost to volunteer at the camp, however, if you stay overnight with the other volunteers at Harnischfeger Park there is a fee (explained on the back of this brochure).
